




INTRODUCTION


Principal's Desk

The Innovations






5th September, 2023- Teacher's Day Celebration


6th September, 2023- Janmashtami Celebration


"Rejoicing in the melody of Lord Krishna's flute"


14 सितम्बर, 2023 - हिन्दी दिवस समारोह

Vikram Batra

Introduction:-

Vikram Batra a name that resonates with bravery and innovation was an exemplary Indian soldier who made a significant impact during the Kargil war of 1999.

Vikram Batra came famed for his valorous acts on the battlefield.

He joined the army force on December 1997.

He died during fighting Jammu force in Kargil War.

July 1999.

Vikram Batra was born in Bramptur Himachal Pradesh on Monday September 9, 1974. Kamal Kanta Batra and Gurdholi Lal Batra were his parents. He was an officer in the Indian army and is best known for the Kargil war. Since he was a child, since Vikram has had a strong desire to join the army. In 1996, Batra passed the CDS test. On December 6, 1997, Batra became a commander in the Indian army. He was made captain after taking part 5140 in the Kargil war of 1999. He was given the Param Vir Chakra. He was also called the "Lion of Kargil" and the "Kargil hero" because of how brave and courageous he was. We don't realize that there are men in uniforms who fight every day to keep us safe while we go about our daily lives. These soldiers have to leave their families behind to keep our families safe. And when danger comes close to our country they make sure it goes away at the cost even if it means giving their lives for us.

The date was December 6, 1997. Vikram Batra's dream came true. As an officer in the Indian Army, he made a vow. Mom and Dad put the shahi on his shoulder with saluting hands. Stand there with a cruel cut and a big smile on his face. After all the hard training, he had lost a few kilos. It was a wonderful time. Vikram knew that life wasn't going to be easy.

Vikram Batra was posthumously awarded the Param Vir Chakra of the Indian highest military honor.


Captain Batra served in the Jammu and Kashmir Police regiment. He is most famous for his hunger in the Kargil war of 1999. He led his team to victory on the difficult battlefield of point 5140.

He is also known as Sher Shah because of his fearlessness and leadership in the Kargil war.

Unfortunately, he died martyred on July 1999, while leading his unit.




तब तक संघर्ष जारी रखिए।

The Evolution of Indian Paintings

Indian art is considered to have originated during the peak of the Indus Valley Civilization, somewhere around 2500 BC. Indian paintings during the time were often inspired by spirituality making it stand out in terms of content and aesthetics, an aspect that is appreciated even today.



The Evolution of Indian Paintings

Ancient civilisation: This period can be dated between 3200 – 1200. This is the time when the Indus Valley civilisation was at its peak. It has been proven that the civilisation was pretty advanced in terms of Science and culture, something that is reflected in the painting curated during the time.

Islamic Influence: With the invasion of the Mughals and other Islamic rulers, came in the beautiful influence of Islamic culture. The Mughals who ruled India from the 16th century to the late 19 century especially left a lasting impression on India's culture, clothing, food and Indian Paintings. The Islamic influence was not only restricted to paintings and sculptures. Trace of their influence was seen in the architecture built during the period.

Colonisation: The arrival of Vasco da Gama was a defining moment when it comes to the western influence on Indian heritage. This period was highly influenced by western, mostly European influence. Be it the French, Portuguese, Denmark or England, the influence of the western world is something that can be experienced even today.



