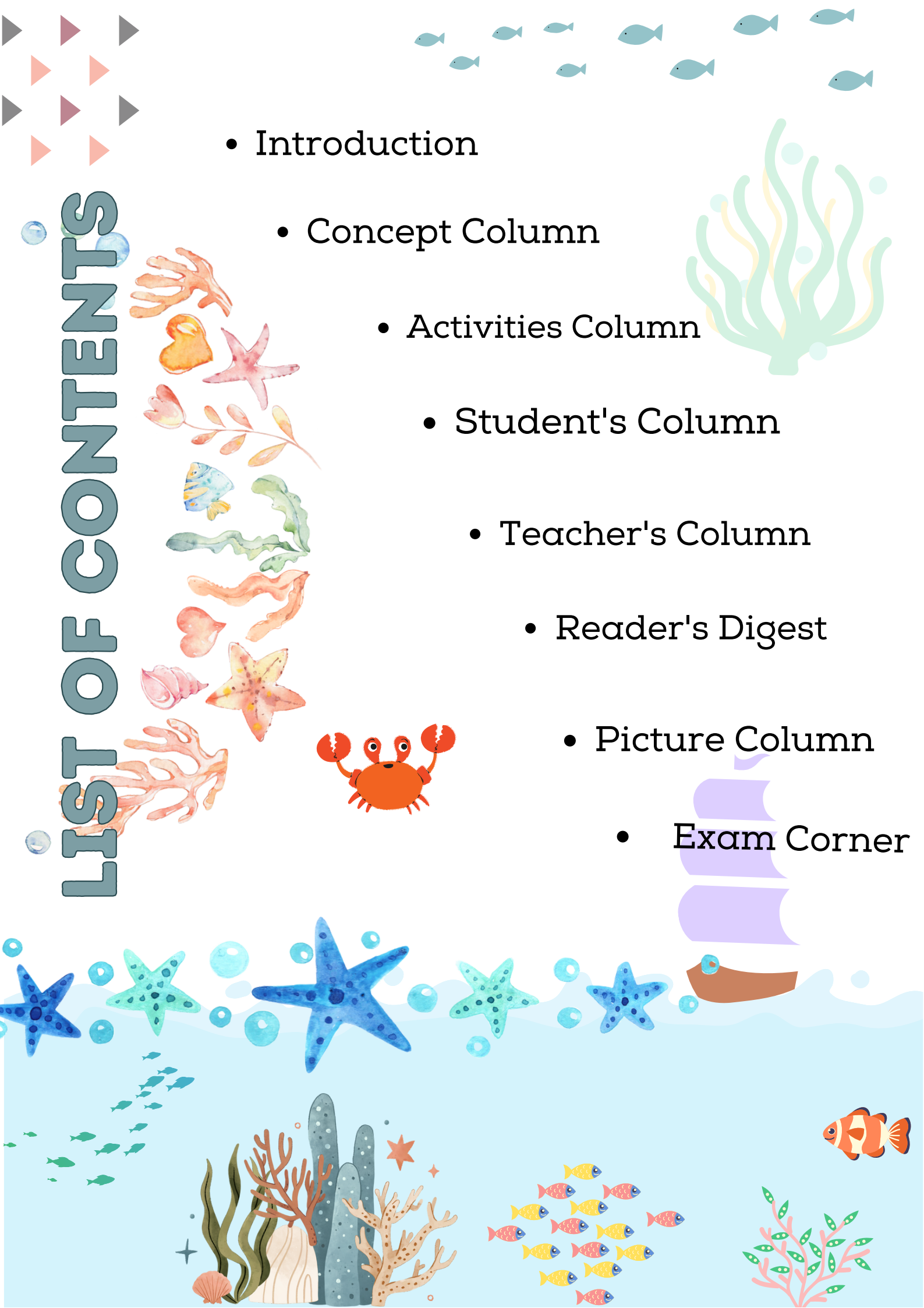

Director's Desk

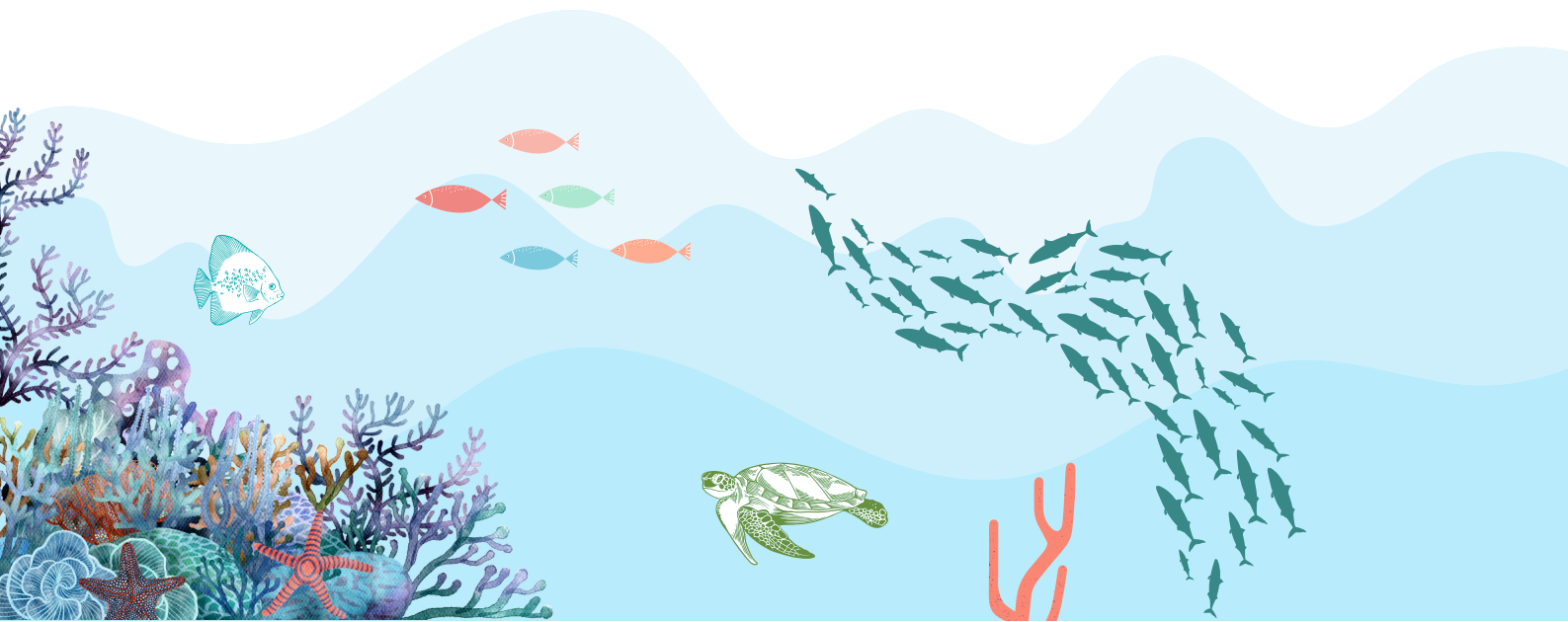

Director's Desk

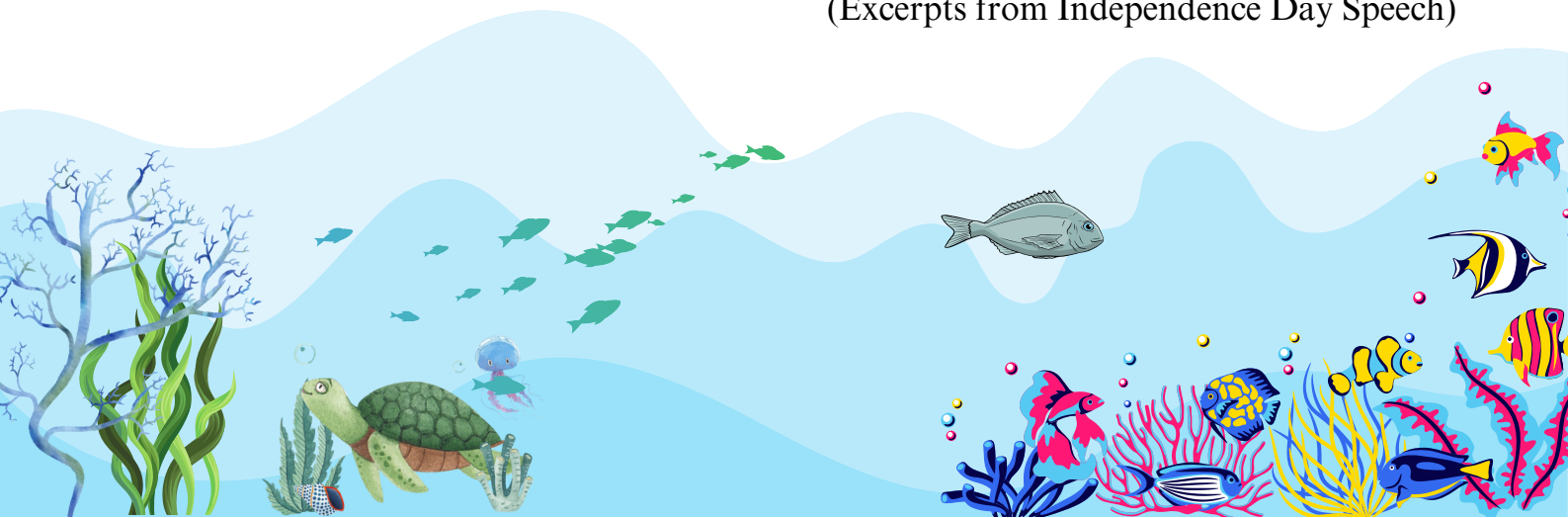

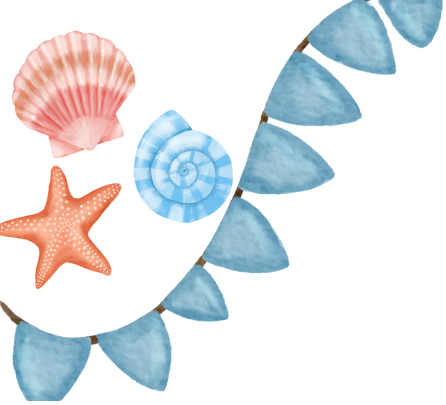

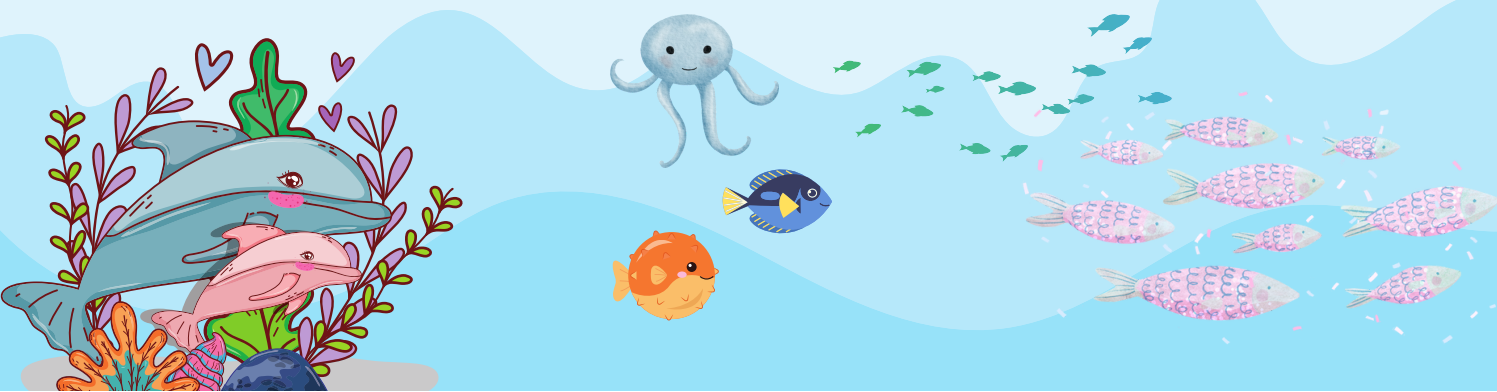
CONCEPT COLUMN

The Innovations

In a special assembly held on August 25th, two students of Class IX- Sumukh Shrivastava and Mayank Kumar Mishra took to the stage to showcase a science experiment. This experiment was about Acids and Bases and how they change colors when mixed as different solutions. Guided by their Science teacher Ms Deepa Kumari, the students explained their whole experiment step by step using a board for conducting the reaction where the word MAGIC was written which changed color again and again when tested with different solutions of Acids and Bases.

Experiments help teach students how to be more observant and inquisitive. They learn how to ask questions, explore new avenues for research, and find new ways on how they can answer a question or solve a problem. Science Experiments emphasize critical thinking skills, problem-solving techniques, communication skills, and higher-order thinking.

We wish to introduce more of such initiatives by our students where they share their classroom teaching with a larger audience which is keen to learn and remember such important concepts in an interesting way.



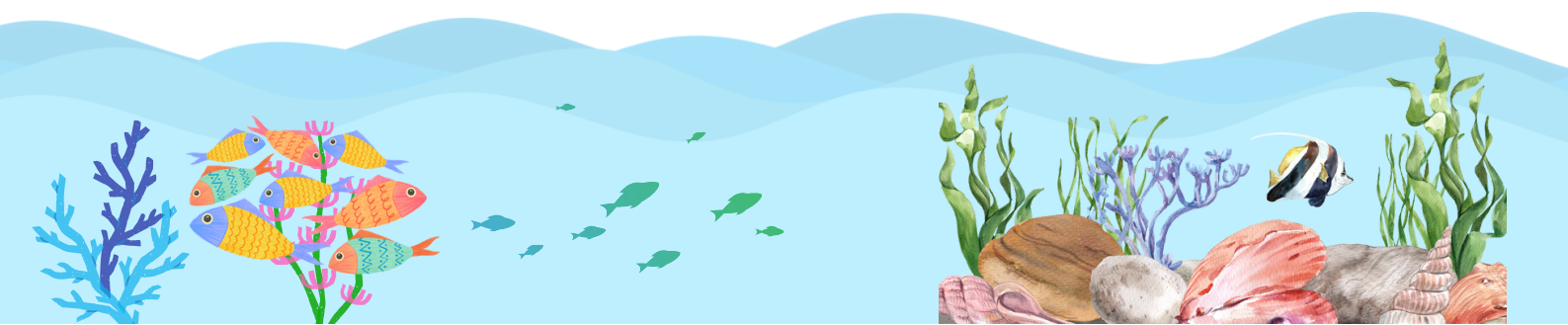

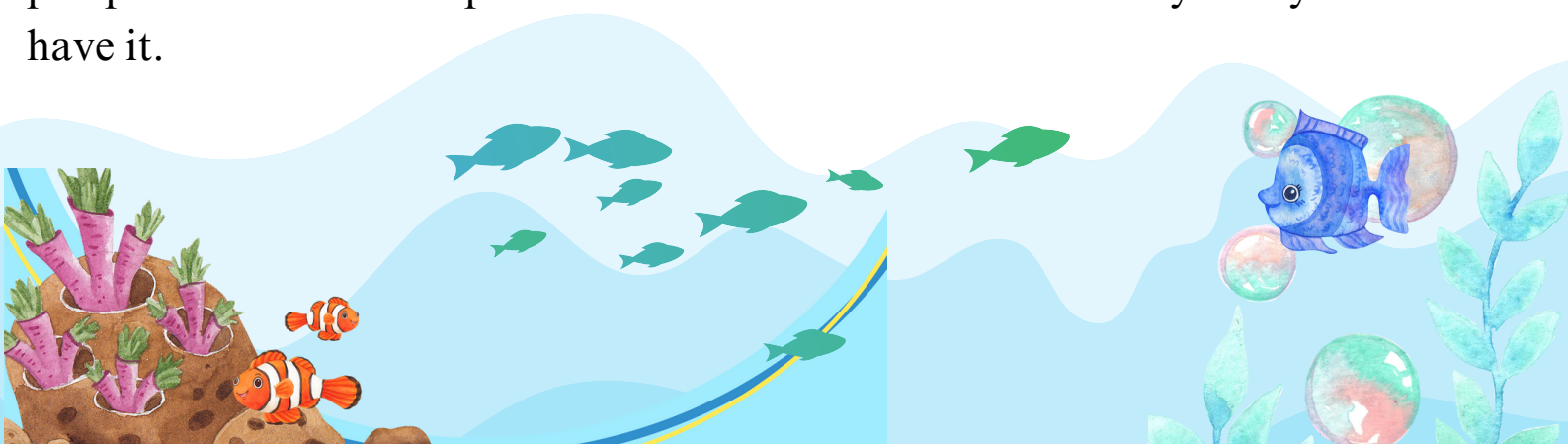


14TH AUGUST, 2023:-PARTITION HORRORS REMEMBRANCE DAY

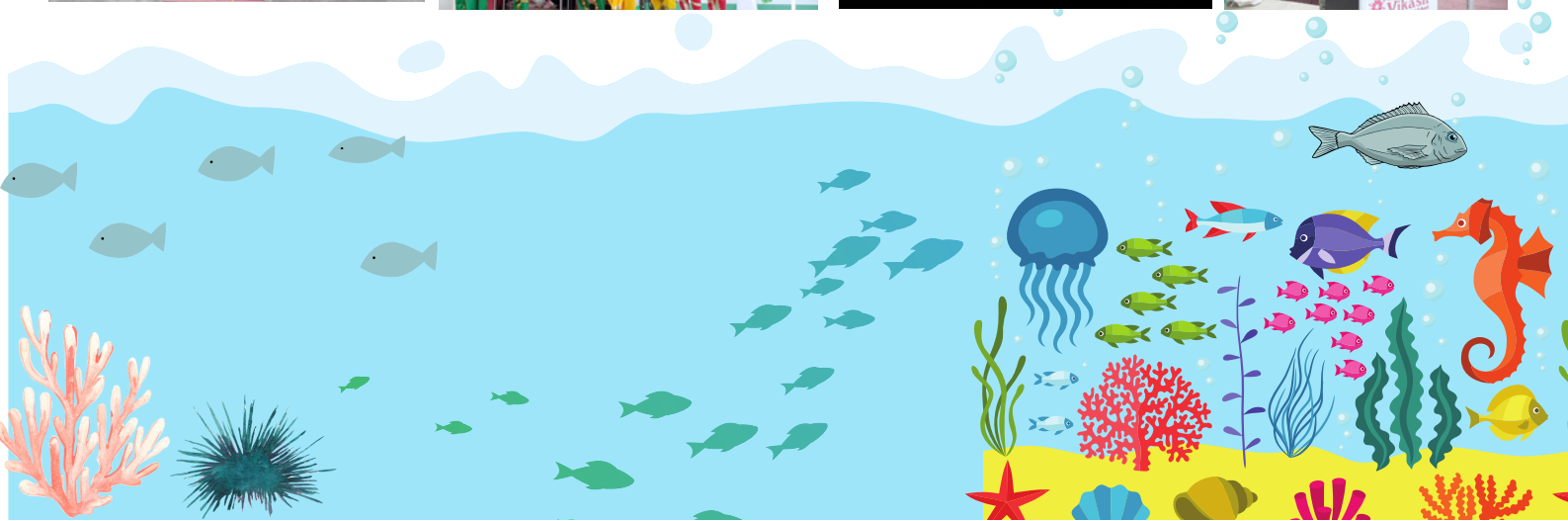


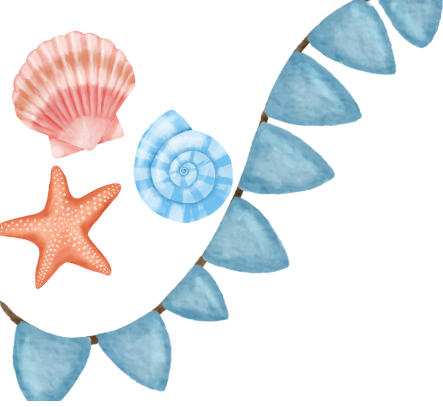


15TH AUGUST, 2023:- INDEPENDENCE DAY

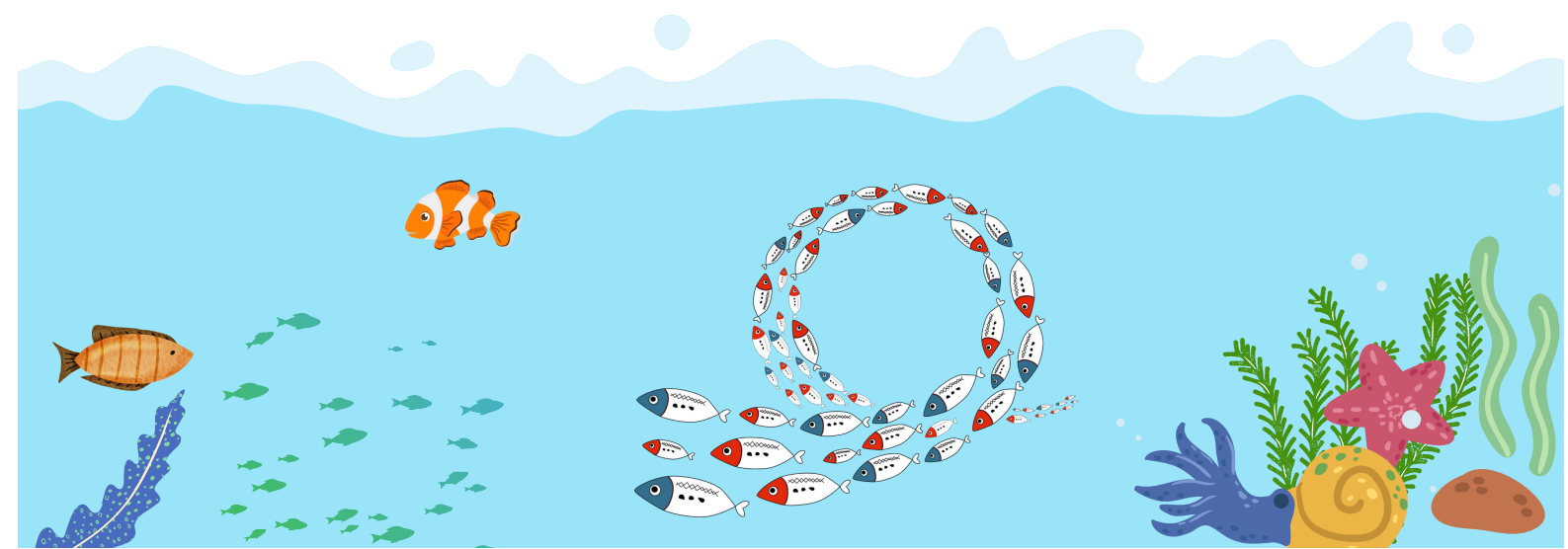
A THIRST FOR KNOWLEDGE COMES FROM...

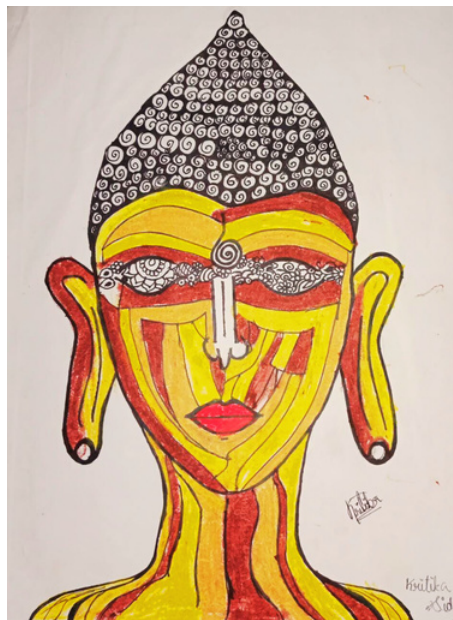
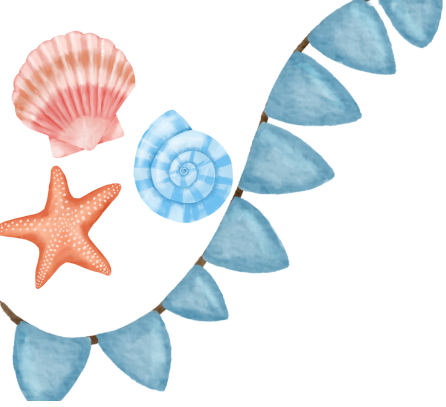

Hope!

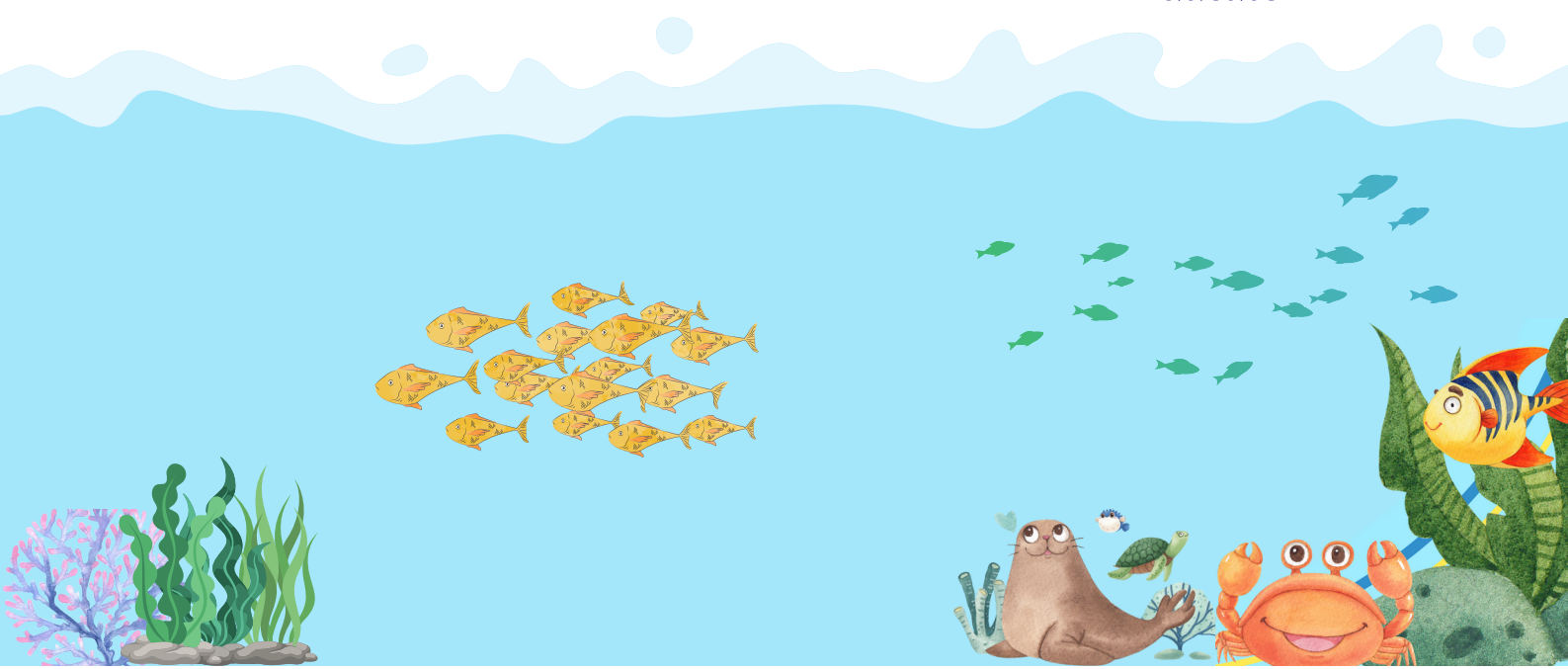
