

The meeting helped to create better understanding between parents and teachers and build harmonious relationship between the school and the community










STUDENT'S COLUMN

better. One should try to keep the message that Holi endorses.






We all felt really relaxed once the exams got over.

Air Traffic Control Management

The operation of the future global air traffic system depends on the efficient and effective management of system capacity, as air transport demand continues to expand faster than system capacity. Even though research in pertinent fields like airport capacity modeling and air traffic flow management has advanced significantly over the past 20 years, there are still gaps in the field, and collaboration between various research fields is necessary to improve the system performance of air traffic management.

Therefore, the purpose of this work is to highlight fruitful research areas by conducting a systematic review of recent research on the topic of air traffic management in the literature. The two tiers of air traffic management papers are examined and classified: system and airport. Air traffic flow management and airspace research are the two primary subjects of study at the system level of aviation transportation. Research subjects at the airport level include aircraft operations in the airport terminal maneuvering area, aircraft ground operations, airport capacity, and airport facility use.


